ORDINANCE NO. 6 OF 2024

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 172 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
 PERTAINING TO LITER IN PUBLIC LITTER CONTAINERS**

Public Litter Containers:

- a) No person may place household refuse, construction, or demolition refuse, or street dirt into public litter receptacle.
- b) No place of business or contractor shall deposit garbage, paper, trade waste, or construction materials in any public litter container placed upon the streets of the City of East Orange for use by the public to prevent littering in the streets.
- c) § 172-20 **Violations and penalties.**

Any person, business, or contractor violating any of the provisions of this chapter, except as provided in § **172-20B**, shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a minimum fine of not less than \$500 for the first offense and not more than \$2,000, imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days, and/or 90 days of community service.
