NOTICE OF ENACTMENT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that after a public hearing held pursuant to the requirements of law on June 20, 2024 and at a meeting held by the Town board of the Town of East Hampton, New York on October 3, 2024, the following Local Law was adopted:

LOCAL LAW NO. 18 OF 2024

INTRODUCTORY NO.16 OF 2024

SECTION I: LEGISLATIVE INTENT:

The Town Board of the Town of East Hampton finds it to be in the best interest of the Town to replace the word "or" with "and" in Subsection C of Section 167-2 of the East Hampton Town Code to provide Ordinance Enforcement with additional tools to enforce Chapter 167.

SECTION II: TOWN CODE AMENDED:

Town Code Chapter 167 ("Littering and Dump Control") is hereby amended by adding the following:

§167-2 ("Public Places")

C.

No person, while a driver or passenger in a vehicle, shall throw or deposit litter upon any street or other public place within the Town. No person shall drive or move any vehicle within the Town, unless the vehicle is constructed and loaded, and its contents are covered ~~or~~ **and** secured, so as to prevent any contents or litter from being dropped or blown from the vehicle or deposited upon any street, alley or other public place or private property.

SECTION III: AUTHORITY

The proposed local law is enacted pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §10(1)(i) and New York State Town Law §130(1).

SECTION IV: SEVERABILITY.

If any section or subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase or provision of this law shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, any judgment made thereby shall not affect the validity of this law as a whole or any part thereof other than the part or provisions so adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION V: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law.
