

**ORDINANCE O.2212-2024**

**EXPLANATION: This Ordinance adds a Residential Parking Zone to Christopher Court**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, “TRAFFIC,” SUBSECTION 17, “RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING,” TO INCLUDE CHRISTOPHER COURT**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Edison wishes to add a Residential parking zone on both sides of Christopher Ct, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. for the entire length.

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Edison is permitted to adopt said ordinance without the approval of the Commissioner of Transportation pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-8; and

**WHEREAS**, as required by N.J.S.A. 39:4-8 the Township Engineer has, provided the appropriate certification.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Council of the Township of Edison, County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey that Chapter VII Traffic, Section 7-17 entitled “Residential Permit Parking” is hereby amended as follows:

Additions are indicated in **bold underline**.

Deletions are indicated by ~~strike through~~.

Language that remains unchanged is not highlighted in anyway.

**SECTION I**

§7-17 Residential Permit Parking

- a. No person shall park a vehicle on streets or parts of streets as described within the following sections unless an appropriate and current parking permit as issued by the Township of Edison is displayed on said vehicle for those streets or parts of streets as described or listed within the following zones.

[no changes to subparagraphs 1, 2, 3, and 4]

- 5. Zone #5. The following streets will constitute residential permit parking Zone #5. Only residents from Zone #5 and their visitors are eligible to park in Zone #5. Color-coded permit(s) will be issued to residents and guests of Zone #5.

[The following shall be inserted between Charles Street and Ventnor Drive]

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**SECTION II**

**SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION III**

**REPEALER.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION IV**

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect after New Jersey Transit receives a copy of this Ordinance, when new bus stop signs are installed, and bus operators are notified of this amendment.
