

Ordinance #375


An Ordinance of the Borough of Elizabethville, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, amending §20-107.1 of the Code of the Borough of Elizabethville, Temporary Containers such as Dumpsters or Bagsters®.

The Borough Council of Elizabethville hereby amends §20-107.1 of the Code of the Borough of Elizabethville to read as follows:


1. Any person using a temporary container, such as a dumpster or Bagster®, in the Borough of Elizabethville, shall secure a permit if the dumpster/Bagster® is placed on a borough street/alley. An application shall be completed on a form supplied by the Borough.
2. Any temporary container, such as a dumpster or Bagster®, placed on any street in the Borough shall have lights, cones or some other type of visibility marker located on and around the dumpster or Bagster®.
3. Any temporary container, such as a dumpster or Bagster®, that is situated on a street in the Borough shall be placed on wooden planks.
4. The person securing the permit shall keep the area around the dumpster and/or Bagster® free of refuse, debris, nails, screws, and any other type of material.
5. Containers, dumpsters, and Bagsters® not in immediate use shall be covered and secured to prevent debris from being blown or washed out of the container.
6. The permit issued by the Borough shall be visible on the property.
7. The permit shall expire within six months from the date it was issued; however, the permit may be renewed by application prior to the expiration date.
8. There shall be a fee for the permit, said fee set by resolution of the Borough Council.
9. A temporary container, such as a dumpster or Bagster®, is one that is on a property for a specific one-time purpose, such as construction debris from contracting work or cleanout of a property, and the dumpster is not there for the day-to-day disposal of municipal waste on a permanent basis.

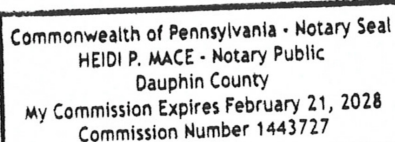


