Ordinance #374

An Ordinance of the Borough of Elizabethville, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, amending Chapter 7, Part 2 of the Code of the Borough of Elizabethville to add §7-202.2 to the Code of the Borough of Elizabethville:

Recreational Fires

- 1. Fire Pits shall be no more than 48" in diameter constructed with a non-combustible outer ring (i.e., masonry, metal) with a sand base or a self-contained device on a non-combustible base (i.e., cement, stone, etc.).
- 2. Burning of yard waste (i.e., leaves, grass clippings, trash, recyclables, or construction material) is prohibited.
- 3. Fires shall be at least 15 feet from any structure, property line, or combustible material (i.e., overhanging branches, etc.).
- 4. A garden hose or extinguisher shall be available for immediate utilization.
- 5. All fires are prohibited from 12am 6 am.

Fire Pit – a pit dug into the ground, encased in a surrounding structure (i.e., masonry or steel) or a self-contained metal/cement/clay device intended for recreational fires.

Enacted as an Ordinance of the Borough of Elizabethville on the 8th day of July, 2024.
