

Ordinance #374

An Ordinance of the Borough of Elizabethville, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, amending Chapter 7, Part 2 of the Code of the Borough of Elizabethville to add §7-202.2 to the Code of the Borough of Elizabethville:

Recreational Fires

1. Fire Pits shall be no more than 48" in diameter constructed with a non-combustible outer ring (i.e., masonry, metal) with a sand base or a self-contained device on a non-combustible base (i.e., cement, stone, etc.).
2. Burning of yard waste (i.e., leaves, grass clippings, trash, recyclables, or construction material) is prohibited.
3. Fires shall be at least 15 feet from any structure, property line, or combustible material (i.e., overhanging branches, etc.).
4. A garden hose or extinguisher shall be available for immediate utilization.
5. All fires are prohibited from 12am – 6 am.

Fire Pit – a pit dug into the ground, encased in a surrounding structure (i.e., masonry or steel) or a self-contained metal/cement/clay device intended for recreational fires.

Enacted as an Ordinance of the Borough of Elizabethville on the 8th day of July, 2024.
