

TRASH AND RECYCLE CAN ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE 2024-08
ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 206-13 RECEPTACLE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS all receptacles required herein shall be supplied by the Township of Elsinboro and kept on the premises and placed prior to collection between the curb and sidewalk, where they shall be readily accessible to the collector.

WHEREAS the occupant or owner shall keep all receptacles clean and in condition for safe handling. Receptacles or other items to be disposed of shall be placed outside after 6:00 p.m. of the day immediately preceding the day of collection.

WHEREAS After collection, any empty containers shall be removed from curbside promptly but no later than 7:00 p.m. of the day of collection.

ALL HOMES –

- A. All trash and Recycle cans **MUST** be Township issued and each Residential lot is entitled to one 90 Gallon Recycle Container and one 90 Gallon Trash Receptacle.
- B. Second containers may be purchased at a cost of \$75.00 each, per year
 - 1. A record will be kept of all residences with a second can and they will be billed annually.
- C. Third containers are not permitted.

VACANT LOTS

- A. Properties without a living structure (open areas or vacant lots) are not eligible to receive trash or recycle containers.

NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

- A. Non Profit organizations are eligible to receive one 90 Gallon Recycle Container and one 90 gallon Trash Receptacle
- B. Requests for 2nd containers will be reviewed on a case by case basis.
 - 1. A record will be kept of all Non-Profit Organizations with a second can.

BUSINESSES

- A. Each business is entitled to one 90 gallon Recycle Container and one 90 Gallon Trash Receptacle.

B. Second Container may be purchased at a cost of \$75.00 each, per year

1. A record will be kept of all Businesses with a second can and they will be billed annually.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance No. 2024-07 was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Elsinboro, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, at a regular meeting held on September 3, 2024. A second reading and public hearing on the foregoing Ordinance will be conducted by the Township Committee at a regular meeting pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-8(b) to be held on October 7, 2024 at 6:00 p.m., at the Elsinboro Township Municipal Building, 619 Salem Ft. Elfsborg Road, Elsinboro, New Jersey 08079, after which the Ordinance will be considered for final passage.
