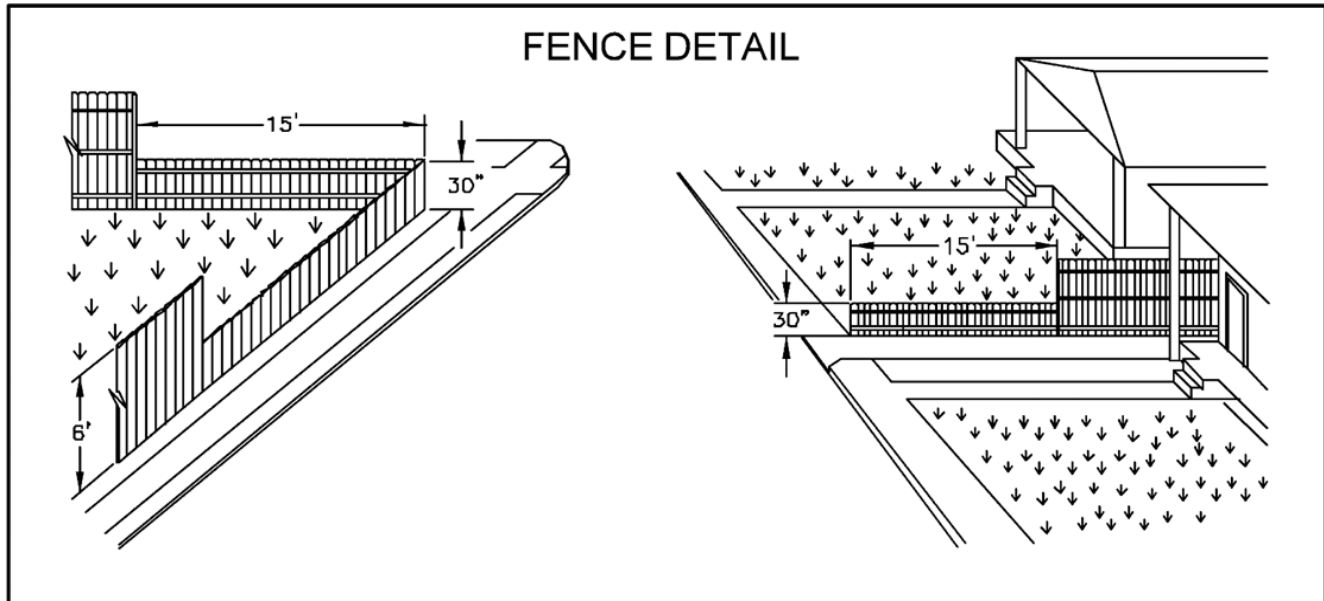

#### Fence / Screening Regulations –

- A fence, hedge or enclosure may be placed **up to but not exceed** the property line.
- No fence, hedge or enclosure shall exceed a height of six feet six inches (6'6") in a Residential District or eight feet six inches (8'6") in any non-residential district.
- Any fence, hedge or enclosure that is not of a "see-through" nature and obstructs vision must be reduced to a maximum of thirty inches (30") within fifteen (15) feet of the front property line or corner as shown above.

**NOTE:** It is the responsibility of the property owner to know the location of property lines prior to the installation of a fence. The front property line is not always the inside edge of the sidewalk.
