Along Bear Tavern Road (CR 579), northbound, on the easterly side thereof at:

- A. Between West Upper Ferry Road and Cardinal Drive — (mid-block)  
Beginning 200 feet north of the northerly curblines of West Upper Ferry Road and extending 135 feet northerly therefrom (location 21952)
- B. Cardinal Drive - (far side)  
Beginning at the northerly curblines of Cardinal Drive and extending 100 feet northerly therefrom (location 21953)
- C. Wheldon Shivers Drive - (far side)

**Section 2.** The Mayor and Council of the Township of Ewing will enforce the needed traffic regulations governing the aforementioned bus stop locations and provide the necessary police security to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

**Section 3** Severability. Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this article be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this article.

**Section 4** Repealer. All prior ordinances or parts of same inconsistent with any provisions of this article are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 5** Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication in accordance with law.

### **STATEMENT**

This Ordinance amends the Revised General Municipal Ordinances of the Township of Ewing to amend the bus stops along county roadways.

### **A RESOLUTION CELEBRATING BLACK HISTORY MONTH**

**Resolution #24R- WHEREAS, the Mayor and Ewing Township Council take pride in recognizing February 2024 as Black History Month, celebrating the many notable contributions that people of African decent have made to our country; and**

**WHEREAS, this year, Black History Month focuses on Black Americans and the Arts and celebrates the profound and evolving impact of Black artistry on our culture, national identity and social movements that have spanned the world over. Through literature, music, architecture, dance, film and every conceivable medium in between, Black artists and intellectuals have used their talents to honor their heritage, educate and inspire and open the minds and hearts of many; and**

**WHEREAS, we recognize this year's Black History Month theme of "African Americans and the Arts" which explores the key influence African Americans have had in the fields of "visual and performing arts, literature, fashion, folklore, language, film, music, architecture, culinary and other forms of cultural expression"; and**

**WHEREAS, for centuries Western intellectuals denied or minimized the contributions of people of African descent to the arts as well as history, even as their artistry in many genres was mimicked and/or stolen. However, we can still see the unbroken chain of Black art production from antiquity to the present, from Egypt across Africa, from Europe to the New World; and**

**The suffering of those in bondage gave birth to the spirituals, the nation's first contribution to music. Blues musicians such as Robert Johnson, McKinley 'Muddy Waters' Morganfield and Riley "BB" B. King created and nurtured a style of music that became the bedrock for gospel, soul, and other still popular (and evolving) forms of music. Black contributions to literature include works by poets like Phillis Wheatley, essays, autobiographies, and novels by writers such as David Walker and Maria Stewart.
