A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR AN *IT PAYS TO PLUG IN: NJ'S ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING GRANT* (Grant Amount: \$200,000.00)

Resolution #26R- WHEREAS electric vehicles (“EVs”) reduce greenhouse gases and other pollutants, which helps improve air quality; and

WHEREAS the State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (“NJDEP”) operates an *It Pay\$ to Plug In* Program (the “Program”) which is designed to expand New Jersey’s growing network of EV infrastructure, allowing residents, businesses, organizations and government agencies to purchase and drive EVs; and

WHEREAS the NJDEP, through the program, is providing financial assistance in the form of reimbursement grants to help offset the cost of purchasing and maintaining DC Fast Charger electric vehicle charging stations at qualifying locations in New Jersey that serve the public, workplace and multi-unit dwellings; and

WHEREAS the Township of Ewing (“Township”) desires to further the public interest by applying for and obtaining a grant from the NJDEP through the program in the amount of approximately \$200,000 for the purchase, installation, and maintenance of one DC Fast Charging Dual Port Electric Charging Station to be installed at the Ewing Senior and Community Center (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Township of Ewing (“Council”) resolves that the proper officials of the Township are hereby authorized to: (a) make application for such a grant; (b) if awarded, to execute a grant agreement (the “Agreement”) with the State of New Jersey for a grant in an amount not more than \$200,000; and (c) to execute any amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Township agrees to comply with all applicable Federal, State and municipal laws, rules and regulations in its performance pursuant to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best public interest of the citizens of the Township of Ewing to apply for such a grant; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Ewing, in the County of Mercer and the State of New Jersey, that the proper officials of the Township of Ewing be and hereby are authorized to submit a grant application and execute a grant agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the State of New Jersey through the

Department of Environmental Protection for an *It Pay\$ to Plug In: NJ's Electric Vehicle Charging Grant* in the amount of \$200,000.

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A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING DEMONSTRATING PROOF OF LOCAL SUPPORT FOR THE SUITABILITY OF A CANNABIS CULTIVATION AND MANUFACTURING FACILITY OPERATED BY JULY'S HARVEST, INC. AT 331 STOKES AVENUE, EWING, NJ 08638

Resolution #26R- WHEREAS, the New Jersey Jake Honig Compassionate Use Medical Cannabis Act, N.J.S.A. 24:6I-2, *et seq.*, and accompanying regulations, N.J.A.C. 17:30A-1, *et seq.*, authorize medical use and possession of cannabis, and related operations, and the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement, Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act (the "Adult Use Act"), N.J.S.A. 24:6I-31, *et seq.*, and accompanying regulations, N.J.A.C. 17:30-1, *et seq.*, authorize the adult use and possession of cannabis, and related operations (collectively the "Cannabis Laws"); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Ewing (the "Township") previously endorsed the expansion of medical and adult use cannabis in the State of New Jersey, and supports safe and appropriate siting of cannabis related businesses and supporting businesses within the Township, including medical and adult use cannabis cultivation businesses; and

WHEREAS, July's Harvest, Inc. (the "Applicant") seeks to hold a tier 1 cultivation and manufacturing license for the cultivation and manufacturing of cannabis products within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant seeks to operate a cannabis cultivation and manufacturing facility at 331 Stokes Avenue, Ewing, NJ 08638 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, an applicant for an annual cannabis business license must submit, among other requirements, proof of local support in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.10(b)(9); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30-5.1(g), a municipality may demonstrate proof of local support for the suitability of a cannabis business's proposed location by indicating that the intended location is appropriately located or otherwise suitable for activities related to the operations of the proposed cannabis business with the adoption of a resolution by the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Township Cannabis Advisory Committee ("CAC") has reviewed the Cannabis Local License Application submitted by the Applicant for the cultivation and manufacturing of cannabis at the Property within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the CAC recommends approval and endorsement of the application submitted by July's Harvest, Inc subject to the reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions imposed by the lawfully enacted Ordinances of the Township, including but not limited to Ordinance No. 21-16 (the "Cannabis Ordinance").

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Ewing Township Council that:

1. July's Harvest, Inc (the "Applicant") seeks to operate a Tier-1 cannabis cultivation and manufacturing facility located at 3331 Stokes Avenue, Ewing, NJ 08638 (the "Property"), which is an area designated for such permitted conditional uses.
2. The Township recognizes not only the suitability of such operations at the Property, but also the benefits a company such as the Applicant would bring to our community as a whole, including, but not limited to, job creation, job training to help reverse the stains on the community by the war on drugs, use of local vendors for build-out and ongoing operational needs, as well as anticipated dedicated tax revenues.
3. The Cannabis Ordinance indicates that the operation of a cultivation and manufacturing facility at the Property is consistent with the zoning rules identified therein. Specifically, cannabis cultivation and manufacturing licenses are a permitted conditional use in the Olden Avenue Redevelopment Area, Parkway Avenue Redevelopment Plan, and Industrial Park-1 (IP-1) and Industrial Park-3 (IP-3) zones.
4. The issuance of a Tier-1 cannabis cultivation and manufacturing license by the CRC would not exceed a license limitation for these types of licenses within the Township.
5. Based on the preceding, the Township is satisfied not only that the Property the Applicant seeks to utilize is compliant with the Township's zoning rules and requirements outlined by the Cannabis Ordinance, but also that the Applicant will be a valuable addition to the group of cannabis license holders awarded by the CRC, and that its business operations will have a positive impact on the Township and community at large.
6. In light of that, and in the event that the CRC issues the Applicant the requested tier-1 cannabis cultivation and manufacturing license in accordance with the Cannabis Laws, this Resolution should be viewed by the State as unequivocal support by the Township of the Applicant, July's Harvest, Inc, and an indication that the intended location is appropriately located or otherwise suitable for the activities related to the manufacturing and cultivation of cannabis.
7. The Township also authorizes the Township Zoning Official to issue any required letter or affidavit identifying that the proposed facility will conform to local zoning requirements allowing for activities related to the operation of a manufacturing and cultivation facility, as outlined in the Cannabis Ordinance, subject to the understanding and agreement with the Applicants that they will comply with any reasonable additional zoning requirements imposed by the Township, which the Township understands and agrees will not occur until after the Applicants obtain preliminary approval by the CRC, and subject to any additional permitting requirements that the Township will impose in accordance with the Cannabis Ordinance.
8. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Resolution #26R- WHEREAS, the Township of Ewing (the “Township”) and the and the Prospect Heights Volunteer Fire Company, No, 1, Inc. (“Fire Company”), previously entered into a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, *et seq.*, adopted by Resolution #20R-82 on April 14, 2020 (the “Shared Services Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Shared Services Agreement was thereafter amended by Resolution #20R-193; and

WHEREAS, the Township and the Fire Company desired to amend the existing Shared Services Agreement clarify when the Township would have access to the Station 31 and certain Fire Company equipment; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the above desire of both Parties, the Township previously passed Resolution #25R-173, approving the execution of the Second Amended Shared Services Agreement, however, prior to the execution of the Second Amended Shared Services Agreement, the Fire Company raised concerns with the language of Paragraph 7 of the Second Amended Shared Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Company desires to further amend the Second Amended Shared Services Agreement to clarify that the Second Amended Shared Services Agreement does not prevent the Fire Company and its volunteers from being eligible for worker’s compensation insurance as allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, the Shared Services Agreement sets forth the basic terms under which the Township may use certain property owned by the Fire Company known as Station 31 and which is located at 1660 Ninth Street, Ewing, NJ 08638 (hereinafter “Facilities”) the Fire Company may use certain vehicles and fire apparatus, personal protective equipment, and other equipment and materials necessary to perform fire suppression duties owned by the Township (hereinafter “Equipment”), and the Fire Company shall provide storage and maintenance for said Equipment pursuant to the

provisions of the applicable statutes and regulations, and the terms of said Shared Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amended Shared Services Agreement also clarifies that the Shared Services Agreement does not prevent the Fire Company and its volunteers from being eligible for worker's compensation insurance as allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, the Township and the Fire Company desire to amend the existing amended Shared Services Agreement in accordance with the attached Second Amended Shared Services Agreement between the Township of Ewing and the Fire Company, which is incorporated herein in its entirety by reference, to clarify when the Township shall have access to the Facility and Equipment and that the Shared Services Agreement does not prevent the Fire Company and its volunteers from being eligible for worker's compensation insurance as allowed by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Ewing Township Council that:

Resolution #26R- WHEREAS a Municipal Clerk is a professional who provides continuity in government from administration, seeing to it that the business of local government continues uninterrupted while providing experienced and dedicated public service to the governing body, colleagues and residents; and
