TOWNSHIP OF EWING ORDINANCE NO 24-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EWING TOWNSHIP SALARY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Ewing that the Salary Ordinance establishing compensation of Officers and Employees of the Township of Ewing for the calendar year 1/1/2024 - 12/31/2024 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. The following Salaries are hereby established for the compensation of Officers and Employees for the fiscal year 1/1/2024 - 12/31/2024:

MUNICIPAL CLERK	\$117,853.20
TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR	\$175,000.00
DIRECTOR, FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$117,593.55

<u>Section 2.</u> In addition to the Salaries payable, all employees not covered by a collective bargaining agreement, except for elected officials, shall be subject to the terms and conditions of the collective bargaining agreement Local 102 of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers A.F.L. – C.I.O., including all future salary increases in accordance with the schedule set forth in such agreement, unless otherwise provided for in a separate contract with the employee. All other employees of the Township, who are members of a collective bargaining agreement, shall be paid in accordance with and are subject to the terms and conditions of their applicable collective bargaining agreement.

<u>Section 3.</u> The following employees are subject to an individual employment contract that has been adopted by the Ewing Township Council, which are incorporated herein by reference: Chief of Police, Deputy Chief of Police and Municipal Court Judge.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2024 and shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

STATEMENT

This Ordinance amends the Salary Ordinance of the Township of Ewing for the position of the Municipal Clerk, Township Administrator, Fire Director, Chief of Police, Deputy Chief of Police and Municipal Court Judge.
