

ORDINANCE NO. 20-10-61

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 230.360 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF EXCELSIOR SPRINGS, MISSOURI RELATED TO TRESPASSING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EXCELSIOR SPRINGS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** That Section 230.360 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Excelsior Springs, Missouri, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 230.360 Trespass in the First Degree.

- A. A person commits the offense of trespass in the first degree if he/she knowingly enters unlawfully or knowingly remains unlawfully in a building or inhabitable structure or upon real property or in a motor vehicle, aircraft, or watercraft.
- B. A person does not commit the offense of trespass by entering or remaining upon real property unless the real property is fenced or otherwise enclosed in a manner designed to exclude intruders or as to which notice against trespass is given by:
1. Actual communication to the actor; or
  2. Posting in a manner reasonably likely to come to the attention of intruders.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
