

ORDINANCE NO. 20-09-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 215.020: APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES—POWERS OF BOARD OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF EXCELSIOR SPRINGS, MISSOURI

WHEREAS, Chapter 215: City Hospital, Section 215.020 Appointment of Member of Board of Trustees—Powers of Board of the Excelsior Springs Municipal Code provides for the number of members of the Board of Trustee and provides for residency requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Excelsior Springs, Missouri (the “City”) have determined it is necessary to revise Section 215.020 to decrease the number of members of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Section 96.170.3, RSMo provides that “In the event the council has provided for a larger board of trustees and subsequently the size of the board is reduced, the trustees then in office shall continue to serve for the remainder of the terms for which they were appointed.”

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Excelsior Springs, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 215 City Hospital, Section 215.020 Appointment of Members of Board of Trustees—Powers of Board is hereby amended, and shall read as follows:

SECTION 215.020 Appointment of Members of Board of Trustees—Powers of Board.


- A. The Mayor shall with the approval of the City Council appoint a Board of seven (7) trustees for the City Hospital. All members must be citizens of the State of Missouri, and shall be chosen with regard to their fitness to serve as same as established by Section 96.160, RSMo. Their powers shall be those set forth in Sections 96.150 through 96.228, RSMo.
- B. The term of the office of trustees and vacancies on the Board will be filled in accordance with Section 96.170, RSMo.

Section 2. Should any provision hereof for any reason be deemed or ruled illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, no other provision of this Ordinance shall be affected; and this Ordinance shall then be construed and enforced as if such illegal or invalid or unconstitutional provision had not been contained herein.

Section 3. The Mayor, the City Manager, the City Clerk and other appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to take any and all actions as may be deemed necessary or convenient to carry out and comply with the intent of this Ordinance and to execute and deliver for and on behalf of the City all certificates, instruments, agreements and other documents, as may be necessary or convenient to perform all matters herein authorized.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
