

ORDINANCE NO. 20-09-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE RELATED TO HELMET
REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, in the 2020 Missouri Legislative Session, House Bill 1963 has been approved and signed by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, among other measures, that bill includes a provision that states that "No political subdivision of this state shall impose a protective headgear requirement on the operator or passenger of a motorcycle or motortricycle"; and


WHEREAS, accordingly, this ordinance repeals those requirements that are currently contained in Section 370.180 of the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EXCELSIOR SPRINGS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 370.180, entitled "Headgear Required — Motorcycles or Motortricycles," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Excelsior Springs, Missouri, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after August 28, 2020.
