



**Minutes of the Public Meeting of the Village Board of Trustees
January 30, 2018 held at 31 South Main Street**

Mayor May opened the meeting at 5:30 P.M.

Attendance

The attendance was taken by roll call.

Mayor May explained that over time the Village Board has received concerns from residents about on-street parking regulations in the village. Village staff was asked to review the parking regulations and to recommend changes where appropriate. The purpose of the meeting is to solicit input from the residents that will be impacted by the proposed changes

Manager White and DPW Superintendent Feeley did a comprehensive review of the village streets from a maintenance and emergency access viewpoint. He asked that those present as residents of the village to provide their viewpoint on the recommendations and any other streets.

Street

James Street: Proposed Change - Potter Place to Dewey Avenue - No parking on both sides (7 a.m. to 4 p.m.)

Consider:

- No parking only when school is in session. (allow parking during school breaks and summer)
- No parking south side only

Nelson Street: Proposed Change - West Church Street to Clifford Street– No parking both sides
Clifford Street to West Avenue- No parking east side

Consider:

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- No parking 75 feet from the intersection with West Church Street. With no parking anywhere on Nelson Street the residents of West Church Street have limited parking in driveways for guests and their service providers, i.e. mail carrier, etc.
- No parking 75 feet from the intersection for those turning left from West Avenue onto Nelson Street.
- No Parking on the east side from West Church St. to a point 75 ft. north of West Ave. (Not sure on the final decision on this)

Deland Park A & B: Proposed Change - Limit parking to one side

Consider:

- No parking Whitney Road to Deland Park B
- “No parking here to Corner” signs
- Restrictions on Park Street
 - Follow up – Park St. already has parking restrictions in place on the east side from Parce Avenue to Whitney Rd. DPW will upgrade and install some new signs and notify FPD for enforcement. Village may want to consider restricting parking on the west side from Whitney Rd to point 50 ft. south.

Baumer Place: Proposed Change - No parking – both sides

Consider:

- No parking south side only
- No parking north side from South Main Street to a point 155 ft. to the west.

Sampson Street: Proposed Change - No parking on both sides

Agreed to by resident.

No representatives of the following streets were present:

Barnum Street: Proposed Change - No parking, West side.

Beardsley Street: Proposed Change – No parking 75’ both sides of intersection at both ends of street

- One resident of Beardsley St. was present.

- Also include Roselawn Ave both sides from Beardsley St. to a point 75 ft. to the west.

Jackson Place: Proposed Change - No parking – both sides
