99 S. Main Street/Pure Oil Building

The property located at 99 S. Main Street, known to the Historic Preservation as the "Pure Oil" building, is available for sale. The Commission is considering this property for historic designation. Knowing the Commission's interest in the property, K. Clark appeared to update the Commission on the Office of Community and Economic Developments (OCED) efforts to purchase the property. Purchasing this property is something OCED has considered in the past. A purchase offer was made and accepted with contingencies. Kevin will keep the Commission informed throughout the process.

Greenvale Rural Cemetery/Discussion

D. Davis-Fritsch updated the survey form for the property and reviewed the changes made with the Commission. At the May 3, 2012 regular meeting of the Commission, a vote will be taken to decide on tentative designation of the cemetery.

Parker Street Bridge/Discussion

110 Hulburt Road

J. Whitney prepared a survey of the property at 110 Hulburt Road and reviewed it with the Commission. She would like to continue her research and discuss it further at the next meeting.
