

TOWN OF FABIUS, NEW YORK SEASONAL PARKING REGULATIONS

ORDINANCE NO: 01-2021

- 1) Authority: New York State V&T Law Sections, 1660 & 1683. Town Law Section 131.
- 2) Enforcement: all public roads, as relates to parking, fall under the jurisdiction, supervision and direction of the Fabius Town Board and any notice of violations of these rules and regulations may be issued by the appropriate law enforcement agency.
- 3) Purpose: To regulate the parking of any vehicle or motor vehicle within the right of way on any portion of certain public ways as hereinafter indicated.
- 4) Winter Parking Ban: For the purpose of snow removal and winter highway maintenance, there shall be no parking upon any public right of way within the Town of Fabius from November 1 to April 1 of each year on the following highways;
 - A) Cowles Settlement Road from the intersection of Vincent Corners Road to the Fabius Town line.
 - B) Herlihy Road for its entire length from NY Route 80 to the Fabius Town Line.
 - C) Shackham Road for its entire length to the Town Line.
- 5) Penalties: Any violation of this ordinance shall result in a fine of \$50 for the first offense and \$100 for the second offense which may incur within one year. Further and at the discretion of the Fabius Town Highway Superintendent and if in his opinion, the vehicle so parked constitutes a public safety hazard, said vehicle shall be towed and the cost of same paid for by the owner of said vehicle.
