Passed the Following Resolution #15-2006


Whereas, the Town Council, of the Town of Fenwick Island, desires to comply with Title 22, Chapter 7 of the Delaware Code, requiring all municipalities to draft and adopt a comprehensive development plan, the Town Council, of the Town of Fenwick Island, hereby adopts by Resolution #15-2006 their intent do so.


Therefore, be it resolved that the Town Council will, on behalf of the citizens and property owners of the Town of Fenwick Island, contract with a reputable organization to develop and prepare a comprehensive plan with the town, containing at minimum a municipal development strategy setting forth the jurisdiction's position on population and housing growth, any expansion plans of boundaries or adjacent areas, community character, general land uses, critical community development and infrastructure issues while respecting the desires of its residents.

Whereas, the Town Council, of the Town of Fenwick Island, in order to accomplish this goal, does hereby establish for this purpose, a Planning Commission, consisting of seven appointed members, with alternating terms, to oversee the development and subsequent implementation of the comprehensive plan.

Therefore, the Town Council of the Town of Fenwick Island does hereby endorse the need for comprehensive plan development, and commits to a review, of the approved comprehensive plan, at least every five years.


