LOCAL LAW NO.1 OF THE YEAR 2024

A local law amending Town of Fishkill the Town Code Chapter 143, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", to add a new Section of the to add a new §143-17A entitled "No U Turns" and a new Schedule "D" entitled "No U Turns".

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Local Law is to promote the public health, safety and welfare by amending Chapter 143 of the Town Code entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" to add a new §143-17A entitled "No U Turns" and a new Schedule "D" entitled "No U Turns".

SECTION 2. MUNICIPAL HOME RULE LAW:

This law is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law § 10(1)(ii)(a)(1) which grants local governments the authority to enact local laws regarding the public health, safety and welfare. To the extent the provisions of this Local Law are in conflict with State law, the Town Board hereby asserts its intention to supersede same pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT OF TOWN CODE:

I. Town of Fishkill the Town Code Chapter 143, entitled Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby amended to add a new §143-17A entitled "No U Turns" and reading as follows:

"§ 143-17 Designation of No U Turn Areas.

It shall be prohibited for vehicles to execute a u-turn on the streets or parts of streets in the locations in the Town of Fishkill listed on Schedule D annexed hereto and incorporated herein.

II. Town of Fishkill the Town Code Chapter 143, entitled Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby amended to add a new Schedule "D" entitled "No U Turns", which shall read as follows and which may be amended from time to time by the Town Board by resolution:

" VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Chapter 143 Attachment 4

Town of Fishkill

Schedule D

No U Turns

Location: Chiappardi Place at the intersection with New York State Route 9D".

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be judged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law will take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State in Albany.
