Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fitchburg, as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED THAT -

§177-15 of the Fitchburg City Code shall be revised as reflected in the chart attached hereto. Specifically, §177-15 shall be revised as follows:

1. §177-15(A) shall be revised by striking the prior fees and listing the new fees as follows:

4. §177-15(D) shall be struck in its entirety and the following shall be inserted in its place:

Water in excess of 200 cubic feet per month, shall be billed at a rate of \$5.67 per 100 cubic feet (748 gallons) from June 1, 2023 until May 31, 2024; \$6.35 from June 1, 2024 until May 31, 2025; \$7.11 from June 1, 2025 until May 31, 2026; \$7.47 from June 1, 2026 until May 31, 2027; and \$7.84 from June 1, 2027 until changed.

5. §177-15(F) shall be revised by striking the prior fee in each subsection and listing the new fees, which are listed and numbered as follows:
