

A LOCAL LAW REPEALING CHAPTER 49 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FORT EDWARD "UNIFORM FIRE PREVENTION AND BUILDING CODE"

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward, in the County of Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward has caused to be drafted a new local law concerning the administration and enforcement of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code (The Uniform Code) and the State Energy Conservation Construction Code (The Energy Code) and does wish to Chapter 49 of the Code of the Village of Fort Edward concerning the administration and enforcement of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code.

Section 2. Repealer.

Chapter 49 of the Code of the Village of Fort Edward is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This chapter shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
