# A LOCAL LAW ABOLISHING THE VILLAGE OF FORT EDWARD POLICE DEPARTMENT

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward, in the County of Washington, as follows:

### Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward has reviewed the staffing and operations of the Village of Fort Edward Police Department and finds that abolishment of the Village of Fort Edward Police Department to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village of Fort Edward.

### Section 2. Abolishment of Village of Fort Edward Police Department.

Effective upon the Effective Date of this Local Law, the Village of Fort Edward Police Department is hereby abolished in accordance with Village Law §8-800.

### Section 3. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

#### Section 4. Effective Date.

This chapter shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
