## Sec. 54.1.F. Handicapped parking on public streets.

No person shall be permitted to stand, stop or park a vehicle in any parking stall designated handicapped parking" unless such vehicle shall have conspicuously displayed thereon a tag issued by the Nassau County Office for the Physically Challenged, or a license plate indicating that the operator or occupant of said vehicle is a handicapped person. The following locations shall be designated for handicapped parking:

**ADD:** Liberty Park Drive, north side, beginning at a point 284 feet from the easterly curbline of Liberty Avenue for a distance of 10 feet in an easterly direction.
