The following directive is an excerpt of the Minutes of the Board of Trustees Meeting of April 8, 2013:

It was moved by Deputy Mayor Piñeyro, seconded by Trustee White that the following resolution be adopted as amended:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, NEW YORK, that the VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS be amended as follows:

Sec. 54.1.F. Handicapped parking on public streets.

No person shall be permitted to stand, stop or park a vehicle in any parking stall designated handicapped parking” unless such vehicle shall have conspicuously displayed thereon a tag issued by the Nassau County Office for the Physically Challenged, or a license plate indicating that the operator or occupant of said vehicle is a handicapped person. The following locations shall be designated for handicapped parking:

ADD: Liberty Park Drive, north side, beginning at a point 284 feet from the easterly curblineline of Liberty Avenue for a distance of 10 feet in an easterly direction.

Section 49-Tow-away zones.

No person shall park a vehicle within the designated areas in the following streets at any time unless otherwise indicated. Any vehicle parked in said designated areas shall be removed pursuant to Section 4:

ADD:

Southside Avenue, south side, beginning at a point 260 feet west of the westerly curbline of South Main Street west for a distance of 125 feet.
