BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, NEW YORK that the VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS Section 41- Parking prohibited at all times unless otherwise designated be amended to add the following:

Section 41- Parking prohibited at all times unless otherwise designated.

REMOVE: Buffalo Avenue, east side, north from East Merrick Road, a distance of 440 feet, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. through 12:00 noon on Monday.

Buffalo Avenue, west side, from the northerly curblin e of East Merrick Road and continuing for a distance of 263 feet in a northerly direction, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Tuesday.

ADD: Buffalo Avenue, east side, from the northerly curblin e of East Merrick Road and continuing a distance of 440 feet in a northerly direction, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. through 10:00 a.m. on Monday.

Buffalo Avenue, west side, from the northerly curblin e of East Merrick Road and continuing for a distance of 263 feet in a northerly direction, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday.
