Section 53-Loading zones.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park an automobile or other vehicles in any space designated and marked as a loading zone or loading area in the following streets at any time or at the times otherwise indicated, except that a vehicle from which goods are being discharged or into which goods are being loaded may occupy such space for a reasonable time. If said loading areas are located in a parking meter zone, said meters shall be effective:

ADD:

Colonial Avenue, south side, beginning at a point 22 feet east of the easterly curbline of North Main Street and continuing for a distance of 52 feet in an easterly direction.
