Sec. 46. No stopping or standing at any time unless otherwise indicated.

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within the designated areas in the following streets at any time unless otherwise indicated:

REMOVE:

St. John's Place, east side, beginning at a point 272 feet south of the southerly curblineline of East Merrick Road in a southerly direction to Mill Road, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

ADD:

St. John's Place, east side, beginning at a point 165 feet south of the southerly curblineline of East Merrick Road in a southerly direction to Mill Road, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.
