# Sec. 44. Thirty-minute parking; locations designated.

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than 30 minutes in the following places:

St. John's Place, east side, beginning at a point 165 feet south of the southerly curbline of East Merrick Road in a southerly direction to Mill Road, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.
