The following directive is an excerpt of the Minutes of the Board of Trustees' Meeting of September 16, 2013:

It was moved by Trustee Martinez, seconded by Deputy Mayor Piñeyro that the following resolution be adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, NEW YORK, that the VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS Article III. Parking Restrictions be amended as follows:

Sec. 46. No stopping or standing at any time unless otherwise indicated.

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within the designated areas in the following streets at any time unless otherwise indicated:

ADD:

Alexander Avenue, south side, beginning at a point 255 feet east of the westerly curblineline of Benson Place east for a distance of 60 feet.
