It was moved by Deputy Mayor Martinez, seconded by Trustee Ellerbe that the following resolution be adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, NEW YORK, that the VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS Section 46- No stopping or standing at any time unless otherwise indicated be amended to **add** the following:

**Section 46. No stopping or standing at any time unless otherwise indicated.**

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within the designated areas in the following streets at any time unless otherwise indicated:

**ADD:**

Bennington Avenue, south side, beginning at a point 69 feet east of the easterly curbline of Columbus Avenue for a distance of 67 feet.

**Section 46. No stopping or standing at any time unless otherwise indicated.**

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within the designated areas in the following streets at any time unless otherwise indicated:

**ADD:**

Main Street, North, east side, beginning at a point 230 feet south of the southerly curbline of Washburn Avenue south for a distance of 50 feet.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, NEW YORK, that the VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS Article III. Parking Restrictions be amended as follows:

**Section 50. Business district permit parking: areas designated; tag required.**

**ADD:**

(d) It shall be unlawful for any person to park an automobile or other vehicle or to permit an automobile or other vehicle to remain in or upon these parking spaces within Municipal Parking Field #27 and Municipal Parking Field #12, designated for the Olive Building.

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, NEW YORK, that the VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS Article III Parking Restrictions be amended as follows:

**Section 54.1. Handicapped parking on public streets.**

F. No person shall be permitted to stand, stop or park a vehicle in any parking stall designated "handicapped parking," unless such vehicle shall have conspicuously displayed thereon a sticker issued by the Nassau County Office for the Handicapped indicating that the operator of said vehicle is a handicapped person. The following locations shall be designated for handicapped parking:

**ADD:**

Lakeview Avenue, west side, beginning at a point 65 feet south of the southerly curbline of Grand Avenue for a distance of 44 feet in a southerly direction.
