The following directive is an excerpt from the Minutes of the Board of Trustees Meeting of June 19, 2017:

It was moved by Trustee Mulé, seconded by Trustee Piñeyro that the following resolution be adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, NEW YORK, that the VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS Article III Parking Restrictions be amended as follows:

Section 54.1. Handicapped parking on public streets.

F. No person shall be permitted to stand, stop or park a vehicle in any parking stall designated "handicapped parking," unless such vehicle shall have conspicuously displayed thereon a sticker issued by the Nassau County Office for the Handicapped indicating that the operator of said vehicle is a handicapped person. The following locations shall be designated for handicapped parking:

ADD:

Sportsmans Avenue, east side, beginning at a point 410 feet south of the southerly curblineline of Cornelius Street and continuing south for a distance of 22 feet.
