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A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 155 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, ENTITLED "PEACE AND GOOD ORDER" BY ADDING ARTICLE XII VIDEO RECORDING ON VILLAGE PROPERTY, §155-98 THROUGH §155-100.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF FREEPORT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 155, Article XII Video Recording on Village Property, §155-98 through §155-100, which reads as follows, is hereby adopted:

Article XII Video Recording on Village Property

§155-98 Legislative intent and purpose.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Freeport recognizes an individual's right to Free Speech and association. However, there may be areas in Village buildings that contain sensitive information and by operation of other laws and regulations, are secure areas in which video recording could jeopardize the health, safety and welfare of Village employees, residents and/or the safe and effective operation of the Village of Freeport. Therefore, such areas should be designated "no video taping zones." This law would accomplish that.

§155-99 Prohibited Acts

- A. Videotaping shall be prohibited where clearly noticed on any Village property.
- B. The Mayor and Board, from time to time, shall designate such areas as "no video taping permitted," by a resolution of the Board.

§155-100 Penalties for Offenses

Any person who violates this section or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$250 for a first offense, \$500 for a second offense, \$750 for any offense thereafter or by imprisonment of not more than 15 days or both.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State's Office.
