AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FREDERICKTOWN, MISSOURI TO AMEND SECTION 710.050 WITHIN TITLE VII, UTILITIES, CHAPTER 710: LIGHT AND POWER, ADJUSTING THE ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE; ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICKTOWN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Subsection A. of Section 710.050, Electric Rates—Automatic Cost of Living Adjustment, in Title VII, Utilities, Chapter 710, Light and Power, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fredericktown, Missouri, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"A. Electric Service Rates. The rates for electric light and power service furnished to the consumer by the City pursuant to this Chapter shall be set from time to time by the Board of Aldermen, by ordinance, pursuant to the recommendations of the Manager of City Utilities. A current schedule of such rates shall be maintained on file in the office of the City Clerk. The following rates shall be in effect until amended or modified as provided herein.

Section 2. It is the intent of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen and it is hereby ordained that this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fredericktown, Missouri, and that sections of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
