ordinance no. 24-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FREDERICKTOWN, MISSOURI TO AMEND SECTION 600.070 IN TITLE VI, BUSINESS AND OCCUPATION, CHAPTER 600: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RELATING TO LICENSE FEES FOR GROCERS; ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICKTOWN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection K in Section 600.070 entitled Fees, Chapter 600 - Alcoholic Beverages is hereby repealed and a new Subsection K in Section 600.070 is enacted in lieu thereof to read as follows:

"Section 600.070 Fees.

(\$150.00).

K. Limited Vendor of Package Liquor — All Kinds. The fee for retailers selling intoxicating liquors containing alcohol in excess of five percent (5%) by weight, in the original package, not to be opened or consumed on the premises where sold by a drugstore, a cigar and tobacco store, a grocery store, a general merchandise store, a confectionery or delicatessen store shall be twenty two dollars and fifty cents (\$22.50) one hundred and fifty dollars

...."

Section 2. It is the intent of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Fredericktown, Missouri, and it is hereby ordained that this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fredericktown, Missouri, and that sections of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion
