

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019-1896 AND APPROVING A NEW ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE PROPERTY, PUBLIC OFFICIAL LIABILITY AND COMMERCIAL INSURANCE POLICIES FOR THE CITY OF FRONTENAC, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City of Frontenac, Missouri, currently maintains property, public official liability and commercial insurance policies; and,

WHEREAS, the aforementioned policies will expire on July 1, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to extend the aforementioned insurance policies for the period of July 1, 2019 through July 1, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has budgeted appropriate funds to cover the cost of coverage.

WHEREAS, the renewal rates for 2019-2020 for property insurance and sales tax interruption insurance are higher than the not-to-exceed amounts approved by Ordinance 2019-1896.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRONTENAC, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section One.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract through The Daniel & Henry Company to provide the City with property insurance not to exceed \$34,984.00, public official liability insurance at \$8,181.00, workers compensation at \$221,237.00, Sales tax interruption insurance not to exceed \$24,425.00, cyber liability \$2,352.00, and commercial insurance policies, to include, but not be limited to, general liability, commercial automobile, professional liability, excess liability/commercial umbrella and equipment coverage at a cost of \$61,429.00.


Section Two.

Section Three.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval by the Mayor.


