

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FRONTENAC AND THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI FOR TECHNOLOGY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, because of increased demands for technology use and legal requirements, cities must engage highly-skilled employees or consultants to perform technology services; and

WHEREAS, it is challenging for individual municipal governments to obtain the most skilled technology personnel at reasonable cost and maintain stability of services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Frontenac has determined that a cooperative arrangement with the City of Chesterfield is an efficient means for establishing and maintaining the City's systems for information sharing, public access and transparency, data storage, efficient governmental operations and other functions; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 70 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri authorizes joint exercise by two or more local governments of any power common to them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRONTENAC, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One:

The Mayor of the City of Frontenac is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental cooperation agreement on behalf of the City with the City of Chesterfield, Missouri for technology services. All terms and conditions shall be substantially in accord with those set forth in the agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

Section Two:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval by the Mayor.
