- 1. There shall be an improvement district known as "Canalview Off-Street Parking Improvement District" bounded as follows: On the east by the center line of NYS Route 481; on the south by the center line of Rochester Street; on the west by the blue line of the Barge Canal; on the north by the irregular property line described in Exhibit A of Urban Renewal Project A-7.
- 2. A special assessment in the amount of \$40,000, effective January 1, 2025, is hereby levied against the Canalview Off-Street Parking Improvement District annually, as follows, the proceeds of which are to be applied to the acquisition, improvement, maintenance and operations costs of the off-street parking areas created by the City of Fulton in the Canalview Off-Street Parking Improvement District.
