The business, activity or operation for which the license or permit is required is subject to all regulations set forth in the chapter to which reference is made and to all other applicable laws and regulations. These fees may be adopted or revised by resolutions adopted by the Common Council from time to time. The fees are subject to change, and the user may confirm the currently effective fee with the Clerk/Chamberlain's office.
