A. Total water service charge (quarterly). Total Water Service Charge = Demand Charge + Usage Charge.

(1) Demand charge (quarterly). Demand Charge = Base Unit Demand Rate x Equivalent Meter Ratio (EMR).

(a) Base unit demand rate: \$30 per quarter. (Water Rate Code 01) (Water Rate Codes 02, 08, 15, 21) (Water Rate Codes 03, 05, 07, 09, 10, 11, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20)

(b) Equivalent meter ratio: based on size of customer's water meter per table below:

1. EMR for other meter sizes to be established by the City Water Department based on safe maximum operating capacity of the meter relative to that of a five-eighths-inch meter.

For residential properties with multifamily buildings that are served by a water meter(s) of a size(s) for which the corresponding EMR is less than the actual number of individual residential units within the multifamily building, then the EMR assessed shall be equal to the actual number of units within the property.
