

Dear Sir/Madam:

For the purpose of filing a local law with the Department of State, number each local law consecutively, beginning with the number one for the first local law filed in each calendar year. Local Law 5 of 2023

Official Map, Chapter 163

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Gardiner, County of Ulster, State of New York, as follows:

1. Statement of Purpose

This Local Law is authorized by the New York State Constitution, the provision of the New York Municipal Home Rule Law, the provisions of the Statute of Local Governments, the relevant provisions of the Town Law of the State of New York, the laws of the Town of Gardiner, and the general police power vested in the Town of Gardiner to promote the health, safety, welfare, and environment of all residents and property owners in the Town.

This Local Law also serves the purpose of bringing certain laws of the Town of Gardiner into accordance with the Town of Gardiner Comprehensive Plan, and Updated Comprehensive Plan.

2. The following Chapter of the Code of the Town of Gardiner is amended and added as follows:

Chapter XX Official Map

§1 Purposes; establishment. To conserve and protect the public health, safety and general welfare, the Town Board of the Town of Gardiner hereby establishes, pursuant to S 270 of the Town Law of the State of New York, an Official Map of the Town of Gardiner showing the streets, highways, trails and parks theretofore laid out, adopted and established by law, which said map shall be final and conclusive with respect to the location and dimensions of the streets and highways and the location of trails and parks shown thereon.

§2 Official Map.

The map accompanying this chapter showing the streets, highways, trails, and parks heretofore laid out, adopted and established by law, is hereby declared to be a part of the Code of the Town of Gardiner and is hereby established as the Official Map of the Town of Gardiner, Ulster County, New York.

### 3. Severability; Repealer

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision of this local law shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this local law shall be deemed valid and effective.

Any local law, ordinance, or part thereof in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

### 4. Effective Date

This local law shall become effective upon filing in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State.
