A local law to amend Town of Gardiner Code Section 164-2 A regarding Senior Citizen Tax Exemptions

Town of Gardiner Code Section 194-2 A is amended as follows:

- The income of the owner or combined income of the owners set forth in Section 194-2A is amended to read \$36,400.00.
- 2 The Income Range and Percent of Exemption set forth in the table of Section 164-2 A is amended as set forth below.

Income Range Percent of Assessment Value Exempted from the Town Tax

This law shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
