GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION, APRIL 4, 2023 DECLARING RESULTS.

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election on a proposition to extend the Capital Improvement Sales Tax was held in the City of Gallatin, Daviess County, Missouri on Tuesday, the 4th day of April 2023, and

WHEREAS, it is provided by law and ordinance that the Board of Aldermen of the City of Gallatin shall assemble and canvass the votes cast at such election, and

WHEREAS, the election results are by the Board of Aldermen taken up and the results of said election is found and declared for the results of the election on the proposition submitted to the voters at said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF GALLATIN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The votes are hereby declared of record on the following “Proposition 1 – Capital Improvement Sales Tax Extension”:

PROPOSITION 1

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT SALES TAX EXTENSION

Shall the City of Gallatin extend its existing sales tax of one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of one percent for the purpose of funding capital improvements which may include the retirement of debt under previously authorized bonded indebtedness*. *(This language is required by state law. There is no bonded debt to be retired.)

The proposition was passed by a vote of **205 Yes** and **90 No**.

Section 2. The vote extended the existing Capital Improvement Sales tax authorized by Sections 94.575 to 94.577 RSMo.

Section 3. The Proposition received a majority of the votes in the April 4, 2023, City Municipal Election. This tax will now have no expiration date. This is effective on the first date of the calendar quarter following the notification to the Department of Revenue.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall forward to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by United States registered mail, a certified copy of this ordinance together with certification of the election returns, and a map clearly showing the boundaries of the City.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
