AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF GARDEN CITY, MISSOURI CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE APRIL 7, 2026 MUNICIPAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, A General Municipal Election was held in and for the City of Garden City on Tuesday, April 7, 2026; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2026 results of said election were certified by Kathy Lambertz, County Clerk/Election Authority of Cass County, Missouri.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF GARDEN CITY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS

Section 1 – It is hereby found and determined by a canvass of votes by the Board of Aldermen of Garden City, Missouri, at the election held on April 7, 2025, in conformity with the Revised Statutes of Missouri and Ordinances of the City of Garden City as follows:

The Board of Aldermen does find that Lane Hernandez is the candidate for Alderman from the East Ward who received the highest number of votes, and shall hold the office for two years, until a successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified according to law.

The Board of Aldermen does find that Ronald (R.J.) Lanie is the candidate for Alderman from the West Ward who received the highest number of votes, and shall hold the office for two years, until a successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified according to law.

Section 2 – It is further found, declared, and determined that notice of said election was duly given and published in the manner provided by law and that said election was held and conducted in all respects in conformity with the Constitution and laws of the State of Missouri governing elections and subject to the provisions for fourth class cities.

Section 3 – That a copy of this ordinance shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 4 – That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: That provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provision hereof is declared invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.
