

ORDINANCE NO. 7623

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATE AND TAX LEVY FOR THE CITY OF GARLAND, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF GARLAND, TEXAS IN CONFORMITY WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AND THE CHARTER PROVISIONS AND ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GARLAND, TEXAS; DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO CAUSE A STATEMENT CONFORMING TO SECTION 26.05(b)(2) OF THE TEXAS TAX CODE TO BE PLACED ON THE HOME PAGE OF THE CITY'S WEBSITE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARLAND, TEXAS:

Section 1

That there is and shall be levied and shall be assessed and collected for the fiscal year 2025-26 an Ad Valorem Tax of \$0.689746 on each One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) assessed value of property located within the city limits of the City of Garland, made taxable by law, which taxes, when collected, shall be appropriated among the funds and departments of the City of Garland for the purposes set forth as follows:

For the General Fund - Operations and Maintenance

\$0.288657

For the Purpose of Paying the Accrued Interest and to Provide a Sinking Fund for General Obligation Bonds and Certificates of Obligation

\$0.401089

TOTAL

\$0.689746

Section 2

That the Ad Valorem Tax rate of Sixty-Eight and Ninety-Seven Hundredths of a Cent (\$0.689746) as set forth in Section 1 above is hereby levied and shall be assessed and collected on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) assessed value of property located within the City of Garland, as valued by the Dallas Central Appraisal District of Dallas County, Collin Central Appraisal District of

Collin County or the Rockwall Central Appraisal District of Rockwall County, as applicable, and made taxable to the City of Garland by law. Assessed value, as used in the following example, means 100% of market value less the 11% residential homestead exemption when, where and if such exemption is applicable.

Section 3

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE INCREASED BY 3.50 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$ 9.76

The Maintenance and Operations tax rate of \$0.288657 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation will increase total city property tax on a \$100,000 home in Garland by 3.50 percent or \$9.76 as compared to the No-New-Revenue (effective) Maintenance and Operations tax rate of \$0.278896 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation.

Section 4

That the Tax Manager of the City of Garland is hereby directed to assess, extend, and enter upon tax rolls of the City of Garland, Texas, for the current taxable year, the amounts and rates herein levied and to keep a current account of same and, when so collected, the same to be deposited in the depository of the City of Garland to be distributed in accordance with this Ordinance.

Section 5

That the City Manager is hereby directed to cause to be placed on the home page of the City's website a statement conforming to Section 26.05(b)(2) of the Texas Tax Code and to post to the City's website the information required by Section 16.18 of the Texas Tax Code in the format prescribed by the Texas Comptroller.

Section 6

That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

Section 7

That this Ordinance shall be and become effective immediately upon and after its passage and approval.


