Town of Geddes Pavilion Reservations

The Town of Geddes Department of Parks and Recreation will begin accepting reservations for the use of the pavilions on **Tuesday**, **January 2**, **2024**.

Lakeland Park is located on Alhan Parkway and the reservation entitles you to the use of the large pavilion, restrooms, and electricity. Facilities at Lakeland Park include tennis courts, basketball courts, field areas and playground equipment. Lindbergh Lawns Park is located on Bennett Ave. in the Lindbergh Lawns area and include a small pavilion, bathrooms, half court basketball area and playground equipment.

To reserve either park pavilion, the following fees apply:

Geddes residents: \$75.00 Rental fee and a \$100.00 security deposit will required.

Non-residents: <u>\$100.00 Rental fee</u> and <u>a \$100.00 security deposit</u> will required. Security deposits will be returned within 10 business days of the rental date, barring any damage to the Pavilion, bathrooms or park grounds.

Reservations must be made at least two (2) weeks in advance. Cancellations must be made at least two (2) weeks in advance by notifying the Department of Parks and Recreation at 487-8238 and a refund will be issued. After two (2) weeks prior, a refund will not be issued. In the case of rain, we do not reschedule permit dates.

Town of Geddes Park Regulations & Policies

In order to **help keep our parks clean, safe and usable by all**, Local Law 8 of the year 2001, entitled "Park Regulations" was enacted to govern park use in the Town of Geddes. The law in its entirety can found in the Town of Geddes Code Book – Chapter 143. Some of the regulations adopted are listed below:

Park Hours: The Town Of Geddes policy towards the hours of use of it's parks shall be as follows:

A. - Parks shall be open for use by the public from <u>8:00 am until 15 minutes prior</u> <u>to Sunset daily</u>. These hours of operation apply to use by the public in general as well as groups who rent orreserve fields within the parks.

B. - No park or field shall be used after sunset and the use of mobile or temporary lighting (e.g. vehicle headlights or roof lights, electric lights, battery operated lights) to artificially light a field afterSunset is expressly prohibited.

Pavilion Use: Memorial Day Weekend to Columbus Day Weekend only.

Facilities and areas in the park shall be used only for the purposes designated or implicit in their character.

No person shall carry into and/or have possession of any **glass** beverage containers.

It shall be unlawful to bring or cause to be brought any animal into any park, recreation or playground area, except for trained guide dogs for the blind which are expressly exempt from all provisions of the chapter.

Fires may not be built or allowed anywhere in park or playground areas except in stoves, fireplaces, or designated areas provided for that purpose.

Licensed motor vehicles shall be permitted only on designated roadways, and vehicles shall be parked in areas of places so provided and designated. Motor scooters, motorcycles, minibikes, go-carts, and snowmobiles shall not be permitted.

Commit any act which is defined as criminal conduct under the New York State Penal Law.

Any conduct which constitutes a violation of this chapter will be a violation, punishable by up to fifteen (15) days in jail and/or a fine of up to \$250.00. Each such violation shall constitute a separate violation punishable under this section.

HELP KEEP OUR PARKS CLEAN AND SAFE, if you see anyone misusing the park - please let us know. To report any problems, etc. call the Geddes Police or the Geddes Recreation Department.

**Also the Town supports the county's initiative in public parks by adopting a "no smoking" policy in town parks. The enforcement of this policy is through voluntary compliance.

Holiday Schedule - 2024 for Garbage and Recycling Pick ups

Garbage and Recycling will not be picked up on the following holidays:

Curbside pickup of YARD WASTE, GARBAGE, **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS & OTHER REFUSE** is for the benefit of Geddes residents. There should be no drop-offs from non-residents to residences located in the Town of Geddes.

**Services performed by the Town of Geddes Highway Dept. are for residents doing the work themselves at their homes.

**Any contractor doing remodeling or repairs on a Town residence is responsible for the disposal of any debris from the remodeling/repairs.

1. BRUSH and YARD WASTE PICK-UP **SCHEDULE**

Monday - Lakeland area (Including Linbergh

Thursday - W.Genesee St., Wilshire Rd., Wynthrop Rd., Hatherleigh Rd., Chaumont Dr., Century Dr., Southview Rd., N.Terry Rd., Timberwolf Circle, Copliegh Dr., Kenyon Dr., Westlind Rd., Westfall Dr., Stanley Dr., Clearview Dr., Horseshoe Dr., Duchess La., Watchtower La., Blackstone Wy., W. Granger Rd. from S.Terry Rd to town line, Limestone La., Treeland Circle, Crabapple La., Blueberry La., Pumpkin La., Spructree La., Kimberly Dr.

Fridays - Westvale area (Westholm Blvd. section to Avery Ave., City Line) – (subject to change due to pick up volume and weather)

Grass Clippings will be picked up during regular yard waste days from April 1st through December 1st as is the current schedule. All grass clippings MUST BE in PA-PER BAGS, CARDBOARD BOXES or a container NOT TO EXCEED 50 lbs. ABSOLUTELY NO PLAS-**TIC BAGS!** (Mulching is a better alternative)

All yard waste, other than tree branches, must be in paper bags, cardboard boxes, trash cans. (NO PLAS-TIC BAGS) - there is a 50 lb limit for barrels and **bags**

Loose raked leaves in wind rows along your front yard (do not put in roadway) will only be picked up from October 1st through Dec. 1st. All other times of the year, rakings must be in paper bags, cardboard boxes,or trash cans. (NO BLUE BINS).

2. BULK ITEM PICK-UP SCHEDULE

Picked up day after garbage and recycling, except Lakeland and Lindbergh Lawns which will be picked

Bulk items include: Furniture (NOT including mattresses/boxsprings), clothing, large plastic toys, etc. ** No full house clean outs

3. **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS**

Picked up day after garbage and recycling, except Lakeland and Lindbergh Lawns which will be picked up on Monday.

No more that 3 cubic yards at one time (equal to a pickup truck full), year round with weather permitting.

Construction debris is: toilets, sinks, bathtubs, shower doors, cabinets, countertops, sheet rock, wood, doors (wood & metal), windows, siding, paneling, insulation, roofing, plywood and electrical.

No fluorescent fixtures

Cardboard, pizza,

pasta, cereal boxes, etc.

Cans and jars

4. WHITE GOODS PICK-UP -

Picked up same day as brush and yard waste.

White good items are – Stoves, dishwashers, clothes dryers, washing machines, hot watertanks, small amounts of scrap metal, etc.

5. CONCRETE, STONES, DIRT, ETC.

A wheelbarrow full (approx. 4 cu. ft.) will be picked up once a month from April 1st through November 1st. Residents must call Highway Garage Department and be placed on list (488-7705)

The following items WILL NOT BE PICKED UP BY OUR DEPT.

Tires, gas tanks, l.p. tanks, car parts, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, microwaves, t.v.'s computer monitors, mattresses and box

The Highway Department does not accept electronics. Please visit **ocrra.org** for recycling options.

Please note: Only wind damage and Christmas Trees will be picked up curbside from December 1st to April $1^{\rm st}$.

Please do not leave any construction debris, bulk items or yard waste in front of the salt barn or in the parking lots at any time.

GARBAGE

Keep in mind that all new fences, sheds (accessory structures), pools, decks, etc. require a Building Permit, even if you are replacing an existing item. Building codes & zoning codes change over the years and the current codes must be addressed and complied with. When obtaining a Building Permit, remember to contact our office for the required inspections.

Complaint forms are available on the Town's website (as well as available in our office) to make it easier for residents to file a complaint. We will address all written complaints submitted to our office. We request all complaints are written on the form provided or by email with all information filled in including your name, address, phone number &

With winter upon us, remember it is signature are required information for our office to successfully investigate each complaint. Complaints are kept confidential therefore we do not want anonymous complaints, because we may need to contact you for more information if we are unable to locate what your concern was in the parcel you are complaining about. Also, by signing the complaint form, it gives us permission to enter your yard to see an issue not visible from the street, for example in a back yard. We can also explain if it does not rise to a level of a citable violation.

> Basketball hoops should not be set up in the road right-of-way. The metal rims projecting out into the street is a very dangerous situation that a school bus, mail truck, garbage truck, an emergency vehicle, etc. could hit with their windshield. We ask that you keep them in your driveway for safety reasons.

EXEMPTIONS

Please be advised, the last day to file for any exemptions for the 2024 tax rolls in the Town of Geddes, is **March 1, 2024**. This includes Senior Citizens with Limited Income, Persons with Disabilities and Limited Income, Veterans, Volunteer Firefighter/Ambulance Workers, Clergy, Business Exemptions, and those turning 65 by December 31, 2024, filing for Enhanced STAR for the first time.

There have been some changes to the STAR Exemption Program. If you are a new owner or do not already have a STAR Exemption on your primary residence, you may qualify for a STAR Relief Check. In order to apply, you will need to contact New York State Department of Taxation and Finance at (518) 457-2036 OR register online at WWW.TAX.NY.GOV and click on "Register for STAR" and follow the instructions.

The Town of Geddes Assessor's Office has mailed out all renewal applications for all other exemptions.

If you are currently in the Enhanced STAR program, you no longer are required to annually renew your Enhanced STAR Exemption with the Assessor Department. Going forward, New York State will automatically renew you based on your income qualifications. If you receive anything from NYS regarding your STAR exemption and need assistance, please do not hesitate to contact our office. If you are receiving the Basic STAR exemption and are now eligible to apply for the Enhanced STAR, please provide a copy of your proof of age, (such as a driver's license) and Federal Income Tax Return for the 2022 tax year, along with your completed applications. Please note that the combined Adiusted Gross Income limit amount

for all owners, and of any owners' spouses residing on the premises for the Enhanced STAR has increased to \$98,700. When renewing for the Senior Citizen with Limited Income or Persons with Disability and Limited Income exemptions, please provide a copy of your 2022 Federal Income Tax Return along with your completed, SIGNED & DATED application and end of the year Social Security Benefit Statement. The cold weather is upon us, here are some safety tips to follow. Take extra time when traveling and make sure your vehicle is clear of snow and ice. Your vehicle's wiper blades should be in good working order. Make sure you have a blanket, extra hats and gloves in your vehicle in the event the vehicle becomes disabled. Our Highway Department does an amazing job during the winter months, so please help them by making sure you don't park your vehicles on the streets during that time frame. Thank You!

The Solvay and Lakeside Fire Departments would like to ask all residents to make sure they have working smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors, especially during the winter months. Many of us try different ways to heat our homes and stay warm, so in the event of a failure or issue a working smoke detector and CO detector can save lives!
