



## ORDINANCE 2024-03

### AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, CHAPTER 116 THEREOF, ENTITLED HOUSING STANDARDS

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN IN COUNCIL MET AND  
HEREBY ORDAINS:

Chapter 116. Housing Standards, of the Code of the Town of Georgetown is hereby amended as  
follows:

§ 116-116 Fire and Carbon Monoxide alarms.

Fire alarms and detecting systems shall be maintained and be suitable for their respective  
purposes.


1. Smoke detection and notification. All smoke alarms shall be listed and labeled in accordance with Underwriters Laboratory (UL) 217 and installed in accordance with the provisions of this code and the household fire warning equipment provisions of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 72, and shall be maintained in compliance with those standards as they may be updated from time to time.
2. Location. Smoke alarms shall be installed in the following locations:
  - a. In each sleeping room.
  - b. Outside each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.
  - c. On each additional story of the dwelling, including basements and habitable attics but not including crawlspaces and uninhabitable attics.
  - d. In dwellings or dwelling units with split levels and without an intervening door between the adjacent levels, a smoke alarm installed on the upper level shall suffice for the adjacent lower level provided that the lower level is less than one full story below the upper level.

3. Carbon monoxide alarms. An approved carbon monoxide alarm shall be installed in the immediate vicinity of all bedrooms in dwelling units within which fuel-fired appliances are installed and in dwelling units that have attached garages.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-05**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, DELAWARE  
BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND ESTABLISHING BUDGET  
AMENDMENT AUTHORITY**

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Georgetown has adopted the provisions of the Town of Georgetown Charter, Article V, Financial Affairs, Powers, and Procedures, Section 5.2 Annual Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town Manager has prepared a budget for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2025 (FY 2025) consistent with the Charter; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town Council does hereby authorize the Town Manager/Town Administrator to transfer any unexpended and unencumbered appropriations, at any time throughout FY 2025, from one line item to another, one object category to another within a department, or one department to another within a fund, without further approval by the Town Council; and

**WHEREAS**, The Budget for the Town of Georgetown for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2025 as submitted by the Town Manager and as amended and adopted by the Town Council on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2024 is hereby ratified; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town Council recommends adoption of the FY 2025 budget totaling \$8,627,232; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF GEORGETOWN:**

**SECTION 1.** The Town Council of the Town of Georgetown does hereby adopt the FY 2025 Budget on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2024 with total resources available in the amount of \$8,627,232 are hereby established as follows:


**SECTION 2.** The Town of Georgetown will no longer accept out-of-town requests for sanitary sewer service. All requests lawfully in place prior to the date of this Resolution shall be grandfathered.

**SECTION 3.** For FY 2025, 100% of the anticipated revenues have been fully appropriated with no funds set aside as promulgated under Resolution #2010-6.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its approval by Council.
