Councilmember WEISS presented the following and moved its adoption:

ORDINANCE MODIFYING GLOVERSVILLE CITY CODE CHAPTER 102-81: OPEN BURNING – PENALTIES FOR OFFENSES

Part 1: Legislative Intent – Following a meeting of the City of Gloversville Public Safety Committee on enhancing enforcement of open burning violations, it has been recommended that a minimum fine be set for violations confirmed by the Fire Department upon conviction.

Part 2: Public Hearing – A public hearing has been held at the Common Council meeting on September 10, 2024 at 6:00PM.

Part 3: Modification – Gloversville City Code section 102-81: Penalties for offenses is now modified to read as follows:

102-81 Penalties for offenses.

Any person violating any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine of not less than \$50, but not to exceed \$1,000, or imprisonment for a period not exceeding 15 days, or both.

Part 4: Effectiveness – A public hearing having been held on September 10, 2024 and upon ratification by Common Council by at least three-fourths of the councilmen in office (6 yes votes), the instant Ordinance shall become effective pursuant to C-28 of the Charter of the City of Gloversville.
