

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CIT OF GLENS FALLS AS FOLLOWS:

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 220-6, ZONING CODE, OF THE CITY OF GLENS FALLS, TO REVISE THE ZONING MAP TO CHANGE THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY FROM MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTAL (R-M) TO GENERAL COMMERCIAL 1 (GC-1) FOR TWO PARCELS, 1 BACON STREET, GLENS FALLS, NEW YORK 12801, TAX MAP NO. 302.20-21-23 AND 3 BACON STREET, GLENS FALLS, NEW YORK 12801, TAX MAP NO. 302.20-21-22.

Section 1. Purpose.

Because City Code Chapter 220, Zoning, is designed to guide the future growth and development of the City of Glens Falls with a well-considered plan of land use, the Common Council recognizes that certain adjustments to its zoning laws must be made from time to time.

The Common Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Glens Falls to make changes in the Zoning District Boundary in the City's Third Ward from Multifamily Residential (R-M) to General Commercial 1 (GC-1) at 1 Bacon Street and 3 Bacon Street, Glens Falls, New York. Stewart's Shops, Inc., proposes to develop the existing lot to expand the Stewart's Shop located at the corner of Glen Sherman Avenue and Bacon Street, to allow for further expansion and growth of the Stewart's Shop located at that intersection. The parcels are currently residential dwellings. The Common Council referred this request to the Glens Falls Planning Board for an advisory opinion. The Glens Falls Planning Board issued a favorable opinion to the request to re-zone.

Section 2. <u>Section 220-6 titled "Zoning Map" of Chapter of the Glens Falls City Code, the "City of Glens Falls.</u> New York Zoning Law" is hereby amended to provide a new subsection "O" to read as follows:

#### N. The Zoning map is amended in the following manner:

The boundary line between the Multifamily Residential (R-M) to General Commercial 1 (GC-1) shall be amended by changing the zoning of two parcels, for 1 Bacon Street, tax map no. 302.20-21-23, and 3 Bacon Street, tax map no. 302.20-21-22, The zoning of the parcels shall be changed from the current Multifamily Residential to General Commercial 1.

Section 3. When Effective.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York, as provided in the Municipal Home Rule Law.

At a regular City of Glens Falls Common Council meeting held on Tuesday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 7:30pm at City Hall, 42 Ridge Street, Glens Falls, New York 12801, the following resolution was passed:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 231**

On the motion of Councilman-At-Large Clark, seconded by Councilman Lapham, all voting affirmatively, it was

**RESOLVED THAT,** the Glens Falls Common Council hereby adopts Local Law (#3-2024) to amend the City of Glens Falls Zoning Code §220-6, to change two parcels, tax map nos. 302.20-21-23 and 302.20-21-22, also known as 1 and 3 Bacon Street, from Multifamily Residential (R-M) to General Commercial 1 (GC-1), with the following condition: Stewarts Shops enters into a Host Benefit Agreement for Cost Sharing with the City of Glens Falls, approved by the City Attorney, that would require Stewarts Shops to contribute no less than \$163,000.00 towards the installation of a turn lane on Sherman Avenue at the intersection of Glen Street.
