

RESOLVED THAT, the Glens Falls Common Council hereby approves to adopt Local Law #2-2024 to amend Chapter 220-6, Zoning Code of the City of Glens Falls, to revise the Zoning Map to change the Zoning District Boundary from General Commercial District 1 (GC1) to General Commercial District 2 (GC2) for two parcels, Tax Map # 309.27-6-1, commonly known as 83 Broad Street, Glens Falls NY 12801, and Tax Map # 309.35-1-9, commonly known as 85 Broad Street, Glens Falls NY 12801 and to authorize the Clerk of the City of Glens Falls to take all actions necessary to publish notice of the Local Law.

Local Law No. 2-2024

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENS FALLS AS FOLLOWS:

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 220-6, ZONING CODE, OF THE CITY OF GLENS FALLS, TO REVISE THE ZONING MAP TO CHANGE THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY FROM General Commercial District 1 (GC1) to General Commercial District 2 (GC2) for two parcels, tax map no. 309.27-6-1, commonly known as 83 Broad Street, Glens Falls, New York 12801 and tax map no. 309.35-1-9, commonly known as 85 Broad Street, Glens Falls, New York 12801, and

Section 1. Purpose.

Because City Code Chapter 220, Zoning, is designed to guide the future growth and development of the City of Giens Falls with a well-considered plan of land use, the Common Council recognizes that certain adjustments to its zoning laws must be made from time to time.

The Common Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Glens Falls to make changes in the Zoning District Boundary in the City's Third Ward from General Commercial 1 (GC-1) to General Commercial 2 (GC-2) at 83 and 85 Broad Street, Glens Falls, New York. The owner, MCP Glens Falls Properties LLC, proposes the development of a self-storage facility on the project site, to allow for the further expansion and growth of the existing Greylock Storage facility located at the adjoining parcel. The parcels are currently vacate lots. The Common Council referred this request to the Glens Falls Planning Board for an advisory opinion. The Glens Falls Planning Board issued a favorable opinion to the request to re-zone.

Section 2 Section 220-6 titled "Zoning Map" of Chapter of the Glens Falls City Code, the "City of Glens Falls, New York Zoning Law" is hereby amended to provide a new subsection "P" to read as follows:

N. The Zoning map is amended in the following manner:

The boundary line between the General Commercial 1 (GC-1) and General Commercial 2 (GC-2), shall be amended by changing the zoning of two parcels, tax map nos. 309.27-6-1, commonly known as 83 Broad Street, Glens Falls, New York 12801 and 309.35-1-9, commonly known as 85 Broad Street, Glens Falls, New York 12801. The zoning of the parcel shall be changed from the current General Commercial 1 to General Commercial 2.

Section 3. When Effective.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York, as provided in the Municipal Home Rule Law.
