**An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 22: City Property, Article I - §22-1 Guidelines**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Glenarden is a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland, and operating under Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and §5-202 of the Annotated Code of Maryland as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 22, Article I §22-1 provides the guidelines for use of City vehicles and property; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has a responsibility to ensure that there is accountability, cost controls, and improved employee safety when City vehicles are in use; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to do achieve these goals a Global Positioning System (GPS) should be instituted;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland sitting in Regular Session this **20th day of November 2023** that:

1. That Chapter 22: City Property - Article I §22-1 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:


**M. All City vehicles shall be equipped with a Global Positioning System (GPS) unit.**

**N. No employee shall not disconnect or attempt to disable the GPS Unit; to do so will lead to disciplinary action to include termination.**

2. The City Manager, Police Chief, Code Manager, and Director of Public Works will have access to the GPS system.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED** by the City Council of Glenarden, Maryland that this Ordinance is and shall become effective twenty days following approval by the Mayor or passage by the Council over the Mayor's veto.


